

# Brand Owner Guidelines













### **Proof Of Origin Platforms and Electronic Registry**

AfCFTA administrators in partnership with the African Union & AfroChampions, are supporting a Proof of Origin architecture that is responsive to the African trading environment and can scale to meet the challenge. The name of this "Solution Network" is: ProPer and the partnership, The ProPer Alliance.

#### ProPer will aid the AfCFTA economies, beginning with Ghana and the FDA to:

- Identify substandard and falsified medical & health products
- Identify counterfeit products
- Ensure product traceability
- Provide regulator and customer-level verifications

By using the tamper-proof tags called ProPerSeals which will serve as a single source of truth for Trade in goods in Ghana and across Africa. Units of goods or their consignments will bear locally and continentally recognized tags.

As economic integration and trade liberalization in the manner envisaged, the AfCFTA presents massive opportunities, but they also pose risks and uncertainties requiring careful safeguards to mitigate and, where possible, to eliminate. Opening the borders to greater and smoother trade and economic interaction could potentially also open the borders to considerable threats. Some of these threats include smuggling, counterfeiting, the trafficking of substandard goods, and various forms of illicit trade. Persons using neighbouring ports for such nefarious activities will seek to exploit the improved connectivity and reduced barriers to flooding Ghana with falsified, fake, substandard, counterfeit, and mislabelled products.

The FDA, therefore, seeks to introduce measures to curtail such developments in a manner consistent with the new AfCFTA reality. With the Guided Trade Initiative's deadline of December 7th creating a tight timeline for phase 1 implementation, the FDA has worked with its partners to craft a strategy designed to generate maximum benefits within the shortest possible time frame and with the lowest possible costs and inconveniences to itself, the industry, allied government agencies, and, above all, consumers. The FDA has joined this alliance to advance the ProPerSeals Protocol based on the four levels of verification framework for Quality, Electronic Surveillance of Safety, Traceability, and Assurance in the supply chain (Questa-4 or Q4).


















Click on List Valid Batches from the dropdown menu


